HRM CIRCULAR 161 OF 2009 – REMUNERATIVE WORK OUTSIDE THE PUBLIC SERVICE (RWOPS)

All staff are to take note of the Human Resources circular which states that:

- Remunerative Work outside the Public Service has been withdrawn with effect from 1 January 2010 whilst the Department reviews controls and processes.
- If applications for RWOPS have already been approved, the end date for those authorities will be 31 December 2009.
- Those empl
- oyees affected in paragraph 2 must be advised in writing accordingly.
- The policy on Remunerative Work outside the Public Service under cover of Human Resource Management Circular No.9 of 2009 is hereby withdrawn with effect from 01/01/2010.

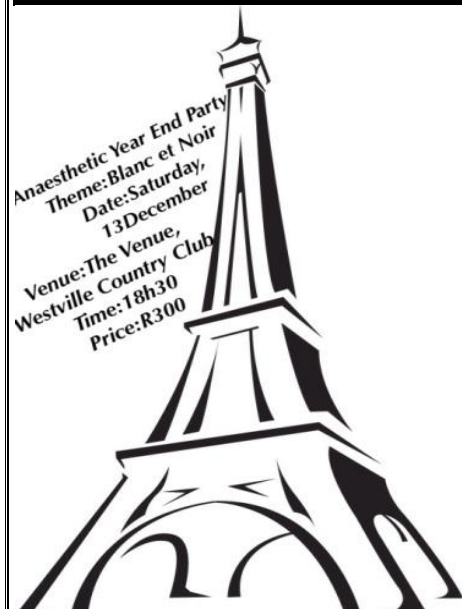
