## ALL MMed STUDENTS AND ACADEMIC STAFF, SCM

Completion of a research project requires completion of the following steps:

1. Formulation of a proposal
2. Completion of a protocol and ethical approval
3. Data collection
4. Analysis of the results
5. Writing up in the form of a coherent report, paper or dissertation.

If a student has not completed every step, they cannot be said to have experienced or demonstrated full proficiency in the research process. Therefore Registrars who wish to be signed off for HPCSA registration purposes need to ensure that they have fully completed each of these steps.

Practically this means the following:

1. Registrars wanting certification for HPCSA will complete the dissertation for the MMed degree and submit it to the Postgrad Office for examination. The research supervisor needs to sign off their satisfaction with the work on the appropriate page within the dissertation.
2. If the student is eligible for immediate registration (i.e. time complete, exams finished), they may request PG Office to arrange an expedited sign-off for HPCSA purposes.
3. In this case, the Dean, Academic Leader of Research or other authorized staff member will review the dissertation urgently. Provided that the work is of acceptable quality, the student will be signed off as "Research component complete" and may apply to HPCSA for registration. Shoddy or incomplete work (data collection, analysis and write-up not completed) will not be signed off.
4. Meanwhile, the examination process will begin and, when complete, the student will graduate with the MMed degree.

Bear in mind however that acceptance of a manuscript for publication by an approved journal will lead to immediate, automatic approval for both HPCSA registration and the MMed degree. This is the way to go!
