## GRANT INNOVATION AND PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT

The South African Medical Research Council is pleased to notify you of the opening of the **2016 Request for Applications for Self-initiated Research Grants.**

The MRC's Self-initiated Research (SIR) Grants Programme is designed to support original research initiated by a researcher at a recognized research institution in various areas of health. SIR grants are in the amount of up to **R200 000** per year for a maximum period of **three years**. These funds provide support for research expenses and it is expected that the researchers/applicants already have in place the necessary equipment and facilities required for the proposed research. Applications are invited in two different categories as follows:

- 1.) early-career researchers
- 2.) Mid-level and established researchers.

The following changes have been introduced to the SIR Programme in 2016:

- New research priority areas are covered
- Individuals working within MRC extra-mural research units are now eligible to apply
- The focus of the call is early-career scientists; however mid-level and established researchers are also invited to apply, provided that a clear focus on capacity building is demonstrated

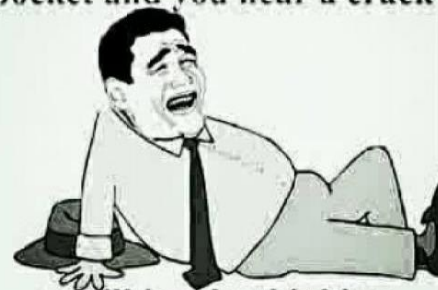
