UKZN – CHS - SCM CONFERENCE FUNDING SEMESTER 2

The School of Clinical Medicine receives limited funds from the College on an annual basis, which it may use to support academic travel. Applications occur twice a year. Travel period, between September and end of November 2019.

A few important guidelines:

- Subject to availability of funds
- The applicant must complete application form and supply all the supporting documentation by the deadline date of **16 August 2019**
- An applicant may not receive funding two years in a row
- To qualify the applicant must be presenting a paper – evidence must be provided of acceptance of the paper when the application is submitted.
- There will be no transfer of funds to another cost centre nor will there be any carry-over of funding.
- The successful applicant will be required to participate in the College of Health Sciences Research Day
- The maximum award for domestic travel will be R10,000 p/person and the maximum award for international travel will be R20,000 p/person....etc

Should you meet the criteria and wish to make an application for travel funding, complete and submit all supporting documentation before the deadline to SCM_conf_fund@ukzn.ac.za

➤ All applications will be reviewed and awarded in accordance with the set criteria and available funding.

➤ Applicants will be notified in writing, within 2 weeks of the deadline, of the outcome of their applications.

➤ Successful applicants will be required to make use of funds in accordance with UKZN financial policies and procedures.
