### TEACHER-OF-THE-YEAR

Nominations to be completed by all Registrars and Medical Officers including PMO's.

This award is made to the Consultant who has made the greatest contribution to teaching of junior staff. The award is voted for by the registrars and medical officers (up to level of Principal Medical Officer).

● Each member of the junior staff will nominate 3 Consultants in order of preference. Consultants will be awarded 3 points as first choice, 2 points as second choice and 1 point as third choice. The Consultant with the most number of points will be declared "Teacher-of-the-Year".
