

## Department of Anaesthetics

### Guideline to Registrar Allocations from January 2012

1. All blocks will be of 3 months duration, except for :
  - Trauma/ICU 2B : paired but 6 weeks each.
  - King George/ King Edward ICU senior/Leave cover in year 4 : This is a “merit “block. Factors considered incl.
    - MMed project progress
    - Presentation at congresses or conferences
    - Clinical performance( green assessment forms)
2. Vascular & Surgical specialities and the Paediatric rotations will be strictly post-primary
3. There will be a transition period in first 6 months of 2012 when registrars may repeat blocks that they have previously completed.
4. Research slots:(Guideline included in revised leave regulations on Dept. site)
  - 5 weeks per 48 months for registrars starting in 2012.Regis starting before this will be allowed 3 weeks.
  - Eligible for 2-week slot if
    - Research methodology & GCP modules completed
    - Hypothesis & protocol presented at combined academic meeting
  - Eligible for 3-week slot if: Protocol approved by BREC & post-graduate committee.
  - Registrars must consult their supervisors weekly & update their progress. Overtime hours will be made up with weekend calls.
5. The proposed 4-year rotation plan below may be modified according to the staffing numbers. The rotations per year will be unchanged, but the number of registrars per block may be adjusted.

**R1 year :**

3 blocks of general (ADH & PMMH & RKK)

1 block of leave cover

Or 1 year at PMB or Port Shepstone

**R2 year :**

1 block Head & neck

1block Trauma /ICU 2B

1 block Obstets –KEH

1block Leave cover

Or 1 year at PMB complex( 2 years total)

**R3 year:**

1 block Paeds - post primary

1 block Cardiothoracics

1 block Vascular - post primary

1 block leave cover /research

**R4 year:**

1 block ICU senior & KGV( merit block) or Leave /research cover

1 Block SR – KEH

1 block SR – IALCH

1 Block Obstets SR IALCH
