HRM Circular No. 16 of 2019

A Directive has been issued on Personal Suitability checks effective from the 1 Feb 2018. The checks shall consist of:

- Criminal record checks**
- Citizen verification**
- Financial record checks**
- Qualification / Study verification**
- Previous employment verification**

Section G of the Z83 application form makes provision for reference checks which will be extended to social media accounts that is public knowledge. Depts may request consent from the candidate(s) for purposes of assessing their social media accounts.

These guidelines will be in practice for the appointment of all new entrants, current employees applying for other posts, employment and or transfers.
