TUTOR TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT COURSE – INVITATION

The UTLO Office has embarked on a Tutor Development Project in collaboration with representatives from Colleges, who comprise the Tutor Development Project Team. In 2018, the Tutor Development Team conducted several workshops, in an attempt to research both UKZN Tutor needs and academics' reflections on Tutors' roles and responsibilities. These workshops have aided the crafting of a blended approach to Tutor training and Development.

The Pilot stage of the programme is ready for trial. We hereby invite Tutors, Academic Development Officers (ADO's) and Supplemental Instruction (SI) Leaders to engage initially with the online programme, which is intended to give current and prospective tutors an introductory, first level training to enable them to develop further or secure appointments as Tutors, ADO's and SI Leaders.

The second stage of the Tutor Development Project will be Tutor Training workshops which will take place on all campuses in August/September 2019.

These workshops will take place once Tutors, ADO's and SI Leaders have completed the online training and attained a pass rate of at least 85% on the online course.
