If you have access to 2 devices or 2 screens, it is suggested you view the webinar on 1 device (like your mobile/screen) and follow the session on your other device (like your laptop/PC/screen). That will give you more flexibility. But even if you have just 1 device, you can still follow the training by toggling between screens.

SUPPORT FOR ONLINE TEACHING AND LEARNING

In response to the imperative to provide alternative modes of teaching and learning, various training opportunities have been developed, and a suite of others are being developed to support academics.

Currently, the following are on offer:

- The Online Activated Teaching (ACT) short-course, facilitated by Dr Craig Blewett
- A series of basic and advanced instructional videos for staff and students on using Moodle, developed by ICS
- Webinars/Workshops on assessing with Moodle, facilitated by Dr Upasana Singh
- Instructional guides and videos on Zoom and MS Teams
- Instructional guide on HandBrake, which is a free video compression tool

It will be available on 1 May 2020, after the installation is completed and training provided.
