The University's Leadership has resolved that no further academic registrations for 2020 will be processed for undergraduate, Honours and Postgraduate Diplomas and Coursework Masters study during 2020. This further implies that no applications for undergraduate, Honours and Postgraduate Diploma, and Coursework Masters admission will be accepted for the second semester of 2020.
