INFORMATION ON THE CALCULATION OF AUTHOR UNITS (AUs) AND PRODUCTIVITY UNITS (PUs) ALIGNED TO THE DHET SUBSIDIZED RESEARCH OUTPUT

UKZN research Productivity Units (PUs) are aligned to the attached research output policy (2015) from (DHET). However, there has been queries and misunderstandings pertaining to the calculation of PUs in line with AUs that are approved by the DHET, from which research subsidy is generated.

Clarity in relation to specific types of research outputs that the DHET subsidizes

1. Approves research articles published in all DHET accredited journals to a maximum of 1AU (60 PUs at UKZN) per article on author proportion basis.
2. Whole Books, Chapters in Books and Conference Proceedings are validated institutionally but the final decision to approve or reject lies with DHET.
 - Whole books are awarded a maximum of 10 AUs (600 PUs at UKZN) based on the total number of pages in the book and calculated on author proportion basis.
 - Articles published in conference proceedings are awarded a maximum of 0.5 AUs (10 PUs at UKZN) calculated on author proportion basis.
 - Chapters in a book are awarded a maximum of 1AU (60 PUs at UKZN) based on the total number of chapters of the book and calculated on author proportion basis. Formulas below are used to calculate units allocated to chapters in a book:
 - > Chapter in a book = 1 AU (60 PUs at UKZN), if the total number of chapters of the book = <= 10.
 - > Chapter in a book = 10/ Total Chapters of the book, if the total number of chapters in the book is >10. For example, if there are 20 chapters in a book, each qualifies for a maximum of 0.5 AU (30 PUs at UKZN).

NB.

1. *Creative Contributions, Patents, and Plant Breeder Rights will from 2020 qualify for DHET subsidy as per the Policy attached.*
2. *Individual AUs and PUs allocations are calculated on author proportion basis.*
3. *In the case where authors are affiliated with two or more DHET claiming institutions, AUs and PUs are divided by the number of affiliated institutions.*
4. *For all the submissions above, final PU changes are made based on the DHET decision to accept or reject the submission; decisions are communicated to the University in January/February post DHET submission. The DHET does not permit any decisions to be appealed.*
5. *The DHET reserves the right to withdraw any journal at any time.*

PROFESSOR BONGANI MAYOSI NETCARE CLINICAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2020

Invitation to medical specialists who wish to further pursue an academic career to apply for the Professor Bongani Mayosi Netcare Clinical Scholarship for 2020.

The scholarship will be awarded to a clinical specialist or sub-specialist for doctoral or post-doctoral research to be conducted in SA. The Scholarship will be awarded an annual salary/stipend for a 3 years period for full-time doctoral or post-doctoral research work in a chosen field.

ELIGIBILITY & CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- SA citizenship
- Registration with the HPCSA as a medical specialist or sub-specialist
- Black persons including persons with disability as contemplated in the Broad Based BEE Act as amended

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:

- 1-2 pages letter of motivation which should include the amount of funds required p.a. for salary support to enable full time research.
- Proof of University registration as a doctoral student
- Full CV outlining research experience and list of publication

The value of the award is informed by the need of the awardee. The award is available from 1 October 2020 or from such other earlier or later date as may be agreed between the awardee, his/her supervisor and the board of Trustees of the Trust.
