MATERNITY LEAVE, INCAPACITY LEAVE AND RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING DURING REGISTRAR TRAINING

The Registrar Programme Steering Committee (RPSC) has resolved that no Registrar's training period shall be extended unless ratified by the Committee accordingly.

It is therefore requested that the following information be submitted to the RPSC:

1. Details of leave requests for Registrars who are taking maternity and/or incapacity leave during their training for RPSC ratification and adjustment of contract dates. Going forward, the RPSC must be notified of any such leave within the semester that the leave/s was taken.
2. Details of any Registrar affected by incapacity leave must be referred to the College's Impairment Committee via Student Support Services.
