REGISTRAR'S COMMUNIQUÉ: EXTENSION OF REGISTRATION

Executive Management has just come out of a constructive and cordial meeting with the SRC Executive (SRC E), during which, following motivated appeals from the SRC Executive, it was agreed that:

1. Acknowledging that the university has met its FTEN enrolment target and that no further registrations can be accepted from FTENs, registration will remain open for returning undergraduate students and new (first entry) and returning postgraduates, in those programmes that still have places available, until **16h00 on Friday 1 March 2024**; giving preference to those students who have already parked their registration.
2. Further noting that AoD documentation will continue to be received until **16h00 on Friday, 23 February 2024** (providing Student Finance with the necessary five (5) working day lead time required to consider the AoDs for potential fee clearance) and that the final day for the minimum fee payment required for registration will be **16h00 on Friday 1 March 2024**.
3. Tied to this extension, the final date for submitting curriculum changes and requests for extended DPs for those modules that had DPs in 2023 will also be **16h00 on Friday, 1 March 2024**.

Students are kindly reminded that registration cycle is currently open to allow for academic progression, they are reminded to register for the **PMED801** module for the year 2024.

SUBSPECIALITY TRAINING COMMUNIQUE

The school is currently finalising the procedures necessary for a subspecialist training programme. Meanwhile, students interested in pursuing subspecialty training under UKZN must enroll in a Non-Degree Purpose qualification within the College. They should select modules within the qualification code and ensure registration for the entire training period (i.e., two years).

The Department of Health requires all appointments to undergo a recruitment and selection process. Therefore, recruitment submissions must be presented to the Registrar Steering Committee.

The enrolment qualification code is NDPSC. This allows UKZN to take responsibility for students undergoing training in their respective disciplines. The Dean will only sign Forms 9 and 57 if the recruitment and registration process has been adhered to.
