REGISTRAR'S COMMUNIQUÉ: EXTENSION OF REGISTRATION

Executive Management has just come out of a constructive and cordial meeting with the SRC Executive (SRC E), during which, following motivated appeals from the SRC Executive, it was agreed that:

1. Acknowledging that the university has met its FTEN enrolment target and that no further registrations can be accepted from FTENs, registration will remain open for returning undergraduate students and new (first entry) and returning postgraduates, in those programmes that still have places available, until **16h00 on Friday 1 March 2024**; giving preference to those students who have already parked their registration.
2. Further noting that AoD documentation will continue to be received until **16h00 on Friday, 23 February 2024** (providing Student Finance with the necessary five (5) working day lead time required to consider the AoDs for potential fee clearance) and that the final day for the minimum fee payment required for registration will be **16h00 on Friday 1 March 2024**.
3. Tied to this extension, the final date for submitting curriculum changes and requests for extended DPs for those modules that had DPs in 2023 will also be **16h00 on Friday, 1 March 2024**.
