## PMDS CYCLE ENDING - 2023/2024 AND NEW PERFORMANCE AGREEMENTS 2024/2025

This is a kind reminder that the EPMDS submission deadline is drawing near (15 -16 May 2024). Please get ready to submit.

Internal HRM circular for your attention and compliance with the timeframes for your departments. Please try and avoid unnecessary work by:

- Using the correct forms with the correct corporate branding (logo)
- Checking that documents are correctly completed before submitting
- Ensure each page is signed by both the employee and the Supervisor/Manager
- Ensure KRA's, GAF's, and the weightings are consistent from the PA to the September review to the Annual review
- Point 12.2 of the PA – the mediator is the person next in the hierarchy to the Manager with whom the agreement was entered into.
- Job Descriptions were submitted last year with a validity period of 31 March 2026. Only new and transferred employees are to submit with the same validity end date.
- **Any underperformance reviews must be accompanied with a Performance Improvement Plan**
